In September 1943, Annunciation School opened its doors in a little house in Crestwood. This September, the entire school community— our current students, our alumni, our current and former parishioners and our friends and neighbors will celebrate the 75th year of our mission of educating students in a Catholic tradition of excellence.

To ensure that Annunciation School will always be able to continue its mission of Catholic education, we have launched **The AES Crestwood Foundation, Inc.** This Foundation is dedicated to the financial support of our school and the promise of an excellent Catholic education for generations to come.

Fundraising for the benefit of Annunciation School will be handled by the Foundation, which will ensure that donations are utilized to sustain and expand existing programs, create innovative new initiatives. keep tuition affordable and ensure that Annunciation continues to be a leader in Catholic education.

A Strong Foundation

Since its creation, Annunciation School has graduated more than 3,700 students. Our enrollment is still one of the largest in the Archdiocese, and we are one of just a few Catholic grammar schools in the Archdiocese of New York who remain parish-based. We are proud of our school, our alumni and our independence.

Recognizing that the strongest schools are built on the strongest foundations, Annunciation School established the Annual Fund in September 2014 to ask our alumni and parishioners to participate in the financial support of the school. Since then, the Annual Fund has raised over \$220,000. It has provided funds for programs for students, including technology and mathematics, as well as professional development for faculty. There is no better time, than the celebration of the 75th Anniversary of the founding of our school, to look forward and imagine that a strong Foundation will ensure that Annunciation School will be able to provide the same quality Catholic education, to have the same independence and to graduate future generations of alumni who will continue to make us proud.

Our Board of Directors, comprised of parishioners and alumni from across the decades, will ensure that donations to the Foundation will be strategically utilized so that Annunciation School remains one of the premier providers of Catholic education in Westchester County.

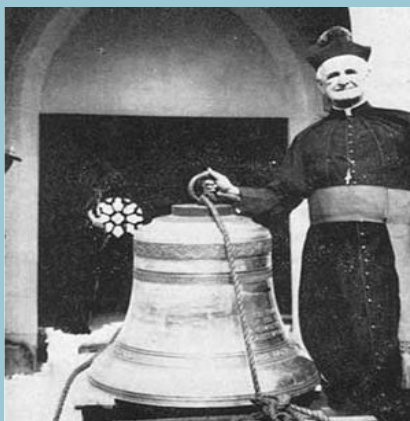
We invite you to join The Monsignor Dugan Society by making a commitment to support the Foundation through a gift in your will or other planned gift.
